They also went through the questionnaire for the Library Survey (discussed on Item V).
- III. Dr. Orson Battad attended the scheduled Library committee meeting headed by Dr. Rene Punsalan (Chairman of the Library Committee for UERMMMCI) on Feb. 16, 2010 at UERMMMC. Library Committee heads from the College of Medicine (Dr. Agnes Arilla-Alba); College of Physical Therapy, and the Graduate School were also in attendance. Dr. Battad reports that the committee pointed out two areas where the alumni can help in the improvement of the library; namely: 1). contribute to the subscription/renewal of their current electronic subscription; and 2). help finance the library with a faster/bigger internet server that will be able to sustain a high volume of users. He also reported that UERMMMC lost the "Cyber Library" sponsored for free to UERM by Pfizer Laboratories.
- IV. Dr. Vic Oyek also visited the Library in January 2010 and donated 2 books and some journals. This was acknowledged by the Librarian, Julie Noces-Gasmen. Dr. Oyek

also reports that the present library will be moved to the top floor (plus annex) of the new College of Nursing building according to the Master Plan presented by UERMMMCI Vice-Chairman Wilson Young.

V. AFUSA's Library Survey was conducted from February to May 31, 2010 through the efforts of our young alumni member, Dr. Michael Mendoza '06 and in coordination with the College of Medicine Library Committee Chairman, Dr. Agnes Arilla-Alba.
